HOW IT'S MADE

We are sometimes asked why, as a producer of luxury high end furniture, we choose to use veneer over solid wood and it is a very valid question.

While solid wood has its own beautiful characteristics and benefits, we believe that these are significantly outweighed by the advantages of using wood veneer. At William Yeoward, as with most high end furniture producers, we use veneer primarily for the creative flexibility, durability, stability, and sustainability it offers.

We choose to prioritise sustainability, and veneer is often considered a more environmentally friendly choice than solid wood, especially when it's made from responsibly harvested wood. This approach helps reduce deforestation.

Veneer allows us to achieve more elaborate and consistent designs, use beautiful and exotic woods more efficiently, and create more stable, long-lasting furniture that can be enjoyed and cherished for years to come.

HOW TO ORDER

Our dedicated team will work with you to create your piece of bespoke furniture guided by the following the steps...

Step 1: *Select your wood - your bespoke piece can be made using ash, oak, walnut or burr poplar. Please note that there are some models that cannot be produced in Burr Poplar. Please see product pages for further information.*

Step 2: *Select your colour finish from one of our six standard colour finishes - Shortbread, Biscuit, Caramel, Cappuccino, Toffee or Chocolate.*

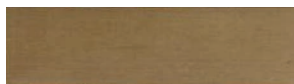
Step 3: *Our team will work with you to agree all detailing i.e banding options on the Barramundi Dining Table, leather and baize options for the Games Table.*

Step 4: *We will send you a detailed quote for your bespoke piece.*

Step 5: *Once the quote has been agreed, we will supply a detailed CAD drawing for approval before production commences.*

Please note our standard lead time for a bespoke piece of furniture is 10-12 weeks.

WOOD FINISHES

When choosing your colour finish, please note that the final appearance will vary depending on which of our standard wood types you choose. The natural base colour of the wood alters the final tone of the finish, while heavier-grained woods show more contrast and "movement" after finishing. Here's an overview of each of our standard wood types in their natural form:

ASH



NATURAL COLOUR/BASE TONE

Light in appearance - typically creamy white to pale beige.

GRAIN STRUCTURE

Straight, coarse, ring-porous grain with a bold pronounced look.

OAK



NATURAL COLOUR/BASE TONE

Pale, slightly yellow or pink undertone.

GRAIN STRUCTURE

Prominent, open grain. Strong texture absorbs more pigment in the open pores.

WALNUT



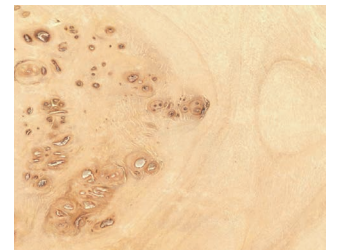
NATURAL COLOUR/BASE TONE

Rich brown to purplish-dark chocolate; the darkest of the three.

GRAIN STRUCTURE

Tighter, smoother grain. More even absorption, less texture visible.

BURR POPLAR



NATURAL COLOUR/BASE TONE

Generally pale cream to light yellowish-brown.

GRAIN STRUCTURE

Highly irregular, swirly grain full of small knots, eyes, and clusters..
